Please make sure your child is in school every single day unless they are too unwell to come to school.

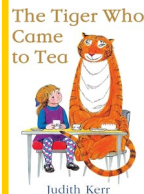
A reminder that gates open at 8:40am and children should be in school by 9am ready to start their learning.
