Science in Year 2: A visit to the Floating Classroom

Year 2 travelled to Paddington to visit the Floating Classroom, where they took part in the **'Amazing Animals'** workshop. They began by bird watching on the canal, using a bird species identification sheet to name the ones they spotted. The children also learnt about how bird beaks, feathers and feet are adaptations that help birds to live in their habitat. Finally, Year 2 worked in pairs to identify which canal animals were carnivores, herbivores or omnivores.
