## Visit to St Paul's Cathedral

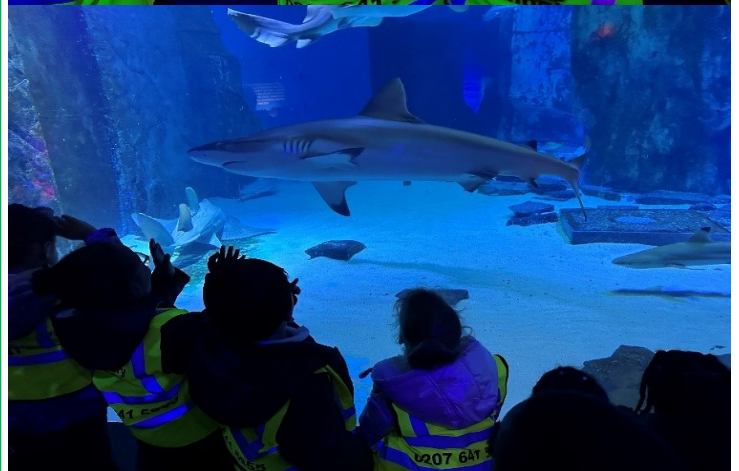
