## New bike and scooter shelter...

At St Luke's, we encourage the children to be **agents of change** and demonstrate **courageous advocacy**. We teach our children the importance of **looking after our world** and also about **healthy living** through the curriculum.



Our School Council recognised that the bike & scooter shelter was often very full, which meant it could be difficult for some children to use it.

In order to encourage more people to choose active travel, to reduce carbon emissions and improve air quality around the school, they came up with the idea to get a bigger shelter.

We applied for a grant through Westminster City Council's 'Schools' Clean Air Fund' to buy a new one.
