## Christian Social Justice Studies

Last week, the children across the school learned about Christian Social Justice, helping them to deepen their understanding of the expectation that Christians make a significant contribution to the 'common good'. The children learned that they can be **Courageous Advocates** (having the courage to make change for the better) and can have an impact on social justice in the world: buying Fair Trade products; raising money for charity; making pledges to make donations to the local foodbank; designing posters to send to the local MP about tackling climate change; and writing letters to Nike, persuading them to treat their workers fairly.
