

St. Luke's C of E Primary School Pupil Questionnaire- Summer 2025

We were pleased to see how positive your responses to the questionnaire were and that so many of you are proud to be at St Luke's. It was a delight to read your comments and suggestions. Thank you for sharing these.

Many children said that you are proud to be at St Luke's and that you have fun and enjoy learning. Many children said they feel safe at school, and commented that if they were worried or scared about something they felt comfortable talking to an adult in school about it.

There were many children who said your teachers are friendly and they will always help you to do better. Some children commented on the friendly and calm environment in the school. One child said, "The classes are all very calm and quiet when you walk in."

All children were able to name a part of collective worship that they enjoy most. Some children said they enjoy showing off their knowledge about religion by answering questions during gospel assemblies.

Many children told us that Meditation is the part of collective worship they enjoy most. You like having a few minutes of everyone being silent and relaxed.

Of course, many children said that playing with their friends at playtime was what you enjoy most. This shows our value of 'friendship'.

Many of you said you enjoy celebrating achievements in celebration assembly; that you like hearing who is 'Person of the Week' and, who has Special Mentions for showing our values and who is a Learning Hero. It's so important to celebrate our own and others' achievements by showing our value of 'community'.

Many children also said that they enjoy the number of different trips and visitors throughout the year. The trips and visitors we choose are linked to the learning that you are doing in the classroom, but we also know how fun and engaging they are. We are pleased to be able to continue to offer a wide range of visits and visitors.

With the ideas for what we can do to make the school even better, a few suggestions included asking for us to get a school pet. This is a wonderful idea, but would be very complicated as we would need somebody to look after the pet when we are not in school. It is also a lot of time and responsibility to consider with a pet that we think is best done at home.

A few children asked for more balls and playground equipment to use during break and lunchtimes. We always try to ensure there is enough equipment for children to use whilst maintaining safety. It would be dangerous to have too many balls and other equipment as there would be an increased risk of children tripping over them and getting injured.

Some children asked for a bigger playground that included a swimming pool, tennis courts or a big football pitch. We would love to have a bigger playground, but there really isn't the room! Year 3 go to swimming lessons throughout the year. Tennis and football are both on the PE curriculum so these are sports you will get to play during the school year. We also have an after-school football club for KS1 and KS2.

Another child said they would like to sit next to their friends in the classroom. Your teachers choose where you sit to help you and your friends learn best by being able to listen well and work hard. There are still lots of times in the day you can play with your friends.

We were delighted to hear that some of you even said there is nothing that the school can do to make it even better!
