Work of the Week!

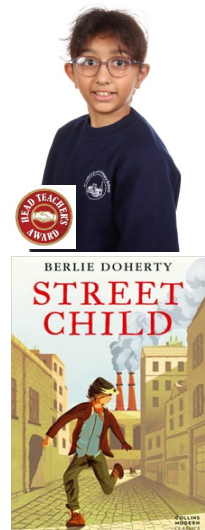


This week's brilliant piece of work displayed in the school lobby is by **Lamaisah** in Year 5.
